

In February 2016, ArchitecturePLB completed the 'Explore Floor' at Kensington Prep School. This large, flexible space is part of the School's ambitious refurbishment work designed to 'create more opportunities for girls to experience self-directed learning, independent exploration and collaborative work.'

The space is brightly coloured with colour themes inspired by Central America, East Asia and Africa. Bespoke floor pillows and moveable foam block furniture can be configured to suit any group size and activity and fold out scribble walls are designed to promote collaborative working.

The space is kitted out with the latest technology, containing interactive learning stations at different heights as well as a fully equipped sound lab for the girls to explore video and sound media.

ArchitecturePLB also worked with the school to design a flexible future classroom based on the latest thinking and research. The designs promote an 'agile classroom' creating a space that can be reconfigured 'on a dime' to engage different kinds of learners and teachers.

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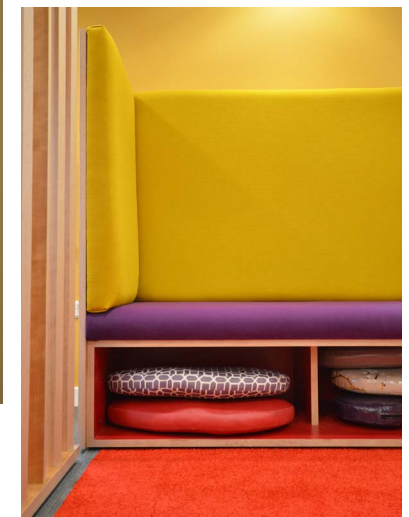
